

In an effort to reduce the exposure of both the public and our staff to the Coronavirus (COVID-19), the City of Trenton is taking precautionary steps effective Monday, December 7th, 2020, which will be assessed on Monday, February 8th, 2021. There will be no public access to the City Building located at 11 East State Street or the Public Works Building located at 2917 Woodsdale Road until that time except for Mayor's Court hours. There will continue to be access to the Police Department. All departments will be available via email or telephone, see below with regards to departmental specifics.

Building/Zoning– During this temporary office closure, and even after the building opens back up contractors and residents are encouraged to submit their zoning or building permit application(s) electronically via email at building-zoning@cityoftrenton.com, via mail, placed in a sealed envelope marked “Building & Zoning” and placed in the City drop box located behind the Historical Museum. All submissions need to have a contact name and number, an email address and a completed application form which is located on the City website: (<https://www.ci.trenton.oh.us/mt-content/uploads/2020/05/building-zoning-permit-application.pdf>). City staff will follow up with the applicant regarding fees. Approved permits can be emailed to applicants and this digital set of approved plans can be utilized as the required onsite copy for inspection purposes.

Finance – Income tax payments and utility payments can be made by mail or the drop box located in the City Parking Lot behind the Historical Society Building. Water payments may continue to be made on-line through the City website at trentonoh.gov, and by credit card or electronic check over the telephone at 513-988-6305. If you need to speak with someone regarding water bill questions, water arrearages, water sign ups, or water emergencies during normal office hours, please call 513-988-6305.

Income tax payments may also continue to be made by credit card over the telephone at 513-988-6305. For income tax preparation, phone appointments may be scheduled during normal business hours. Documents must be received in the tax office via mail, or the drop box, prior to your scheduled phone appointment. Contact the tax office at tax@cityoftrenton.com or you can call 513-428-0158, or you can email water@ci.trenton.oh.us.

Applications for CARES Act business relief funds may be submitted by phone appointment. Phone appointments may be scheduled during normal business hours. Documents must be received in the Finance Office via mail, or the drop box, prior to your scheduled phone appointment. Contact the Finance Office at lfletcher@ci.trenton.oh.us, or call 513-267-0864.

Fire Department – All public education classes, fire inspections, and tours are suspended. High risk/high hazard inspections to be reviewed by Fire Administration.
