A note to our residents and those needing law enforcement assistance in the City of Trenton:

As our Nation and the world deal with Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), our department must take steps to ensure that our officers and staff remain healthy and stay safe so that we can continue to aid our residents and businesses to the best of our ability. In this light, it is necessary that some temporary changes are made to the manner in which our officers respond to incidents within our community.

Officers will continue to respond as usual to reports of:

- Violent crimes – family violence, assaults where there is injury, kidnapping, robbery, etc.;
- Sex crimes – rape, sexual assault, etc.;
- Stolen vehicles;
- Stolen firearms;
- Traffic accidents; and
- Child abuse.


Please note: Firearms cannot be reported stolen via phone; nor can materials that are hazardous to public safety, e.g., explosives or highly toxic substances.

Officers and dispatchers will encourage reporting over the phone for those incidents not specifically requiring officer presence, such as:

- Theft of property from a motor vehicle
- Theft of property with a value of less than \$2,500
- Simple assault
- Criminal mischief (vandalism)
- Harassment
- Lost or missing property
- Identity theft
- Debit and/or credit card abuse

These lists are not all-inclusive. When reporting over the phone, please be sure to provide a current telephone number and valid email address if you have one in case more information is needed. In non-emergency situations, you may wait to come to the police department to make your report instead of reporting over the phone.
